Subject: Recognition Certificate for the school under sub-rule 4 of Rule 12 of Karnataka Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2010 and under section 18 of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009.

2. As per the proposal submitted by school Dated:
21/11/2017.

With reference to your application dated: 21/11/2017 and subsequent correspondence with the School / Inspection by departmental officers, I convey the grant of provisional recognition to the **SRI CHAITANYA TECHNO SCHOOL, # 2, B.P WADIA ROAD, BASAVANGUDI, BANGALORE-560004 (DISE CODE: 29200139518)**, for classes 1st Std to 8th Std for a period of FIVE years and subject to fulfillment of following conditions:


1. This is a provisional grant of recognition under the RTE Act and rules and is not extendable beyond Class VIII.
2. The school shall abide by all the provisions of the RTE Act 2009 and the RTE Rules 2010 referred here in.
3. The school shall admit in Class I, to the extent of 25% of the strength of the class, children belonging to weaker sections and disadvantaged groups in the neighborhood and provide free and compulsory education till completion of elementary education. Provided that if the school admits children in pre-primary classes also, the school shall follow these norms. The children so admitted shall not be discriminated from the rest of the children or segregated or treated separately in any manner.
4. For the children referred in paragraph 3. the school shall be reimbursed as per section 12(2) of the Act. In order to receive such reimbursements, the school shall open and maintain a separate bank account which is subject to audit by the department.
5. The Society / School shall not collect any capitation fee or voluntary donations from the parents of children at any time either during admission or during the course of the academic year. The school shall collect only tuition and other fee as approved by the department. The scale of fee shall be notified by the school and displayed prominently in the school premises.
6. The school shall not subject the child or the parents to any screening procedure including any test and interview.
7. Admission shall be made only during the period notified by the department.

8. The school shall not deny admission to any child.
 - I. For lack of age proof
 - II. On grounds of Caste, Religion, Race or Place of birth, Language.
 - III. If admission is sought subsequent to the extended period of admission
9. The school shall ensure:
 - I. No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till completion of elementary education in a school
 - II. No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
 - III. No child is required to pass any Board examination till the completion of elementary education.
 - IV. Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under Rule 21.
 - V. The school shall also admit children with special needs / special children as per provisions of the Act.
 - VI. The teachers recruited have minimum qualifications as is prescribed for elementary school teachers in the RTE Rules.
 - VII. The salary and allowances payable to and the terms and conditions of service of teachers shall be as prescribed by the state Government and the salaries are paid to teachers only through bank.
 - VIII. The teachers perform the duties prescribed under section 24(1) of the Act and Rule 17 of the RTE Rules and shall not engage themselves in private tuitions for monetary considerations.
10. The school shall follow the curriculum and text books of the academic authority to which it is affiliated.
11. The school shall admit students in proportion to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Section 19 of the Act.
12. The school shall maintain the norms and standards as specified in Section 19 of the Act, the deficiencies noticed by the departmental staff are given in the annexure.
13. The school shall not run any unauthorized classes / sections either within the school premises or outside.
14. The school buildings another infrastructure facilities should not be used either during day or night for any commercial activities or for political and non-educational activities
15. The school shall not be run for profit to any individual or group or association of persons.
16. The accounts of the school are audited by a Chartered Accountant and a copy of such audited statements is sent to the DDPI / BEO by end of June every year.

Special note:

1. The guidelines issued regarding the safety measures of the children must be strictly followed and if any damage or violation in this regard is noticed the Management and the school is held responsible.
2. The Management has to register the school details in the department website.

2. As per Kamataka Education Institutions (Classification, Controlling and Fixation of Text etc.,) of Rules 1995 of Rule 4,5,6 and 8, for safety measures this School Building must have good quality of Roofing, Clean good air and must have light properly. To provide Drinking Water and to provide Toilets separately for male and female children. To provide fencing to the dangerous places of the School premises and also to provide Compound for children's safety. and it is compulsory.
3. To provide school premises to avoid harms from Fire Accident, Electric Circuits and other incidents and thereby to provide safety measures to the students and Teaching Staff and also to follow strictly of the Hon'ble Supreme Court Direction as per Case No.483/2004 Dt: 13.4.2009.
4. This Educational Institution shall not open any other extra Sections without the prior approval of the Government.
5. The School is to be opened as per the grant of Medium and at same place and for no reason there shall not be scope for change of place as per Kamataka Education Act Section 41(5).
6. For which school Management permission has been given same Managing Committee has to run the same at the same place and in the same name. and for no reason without the proper prior approval of the Government shall not transfer/shift/or transfer the said institution.
7. This Educational Institution has to follow all the Government Orders and Rules with regard to the Education Institutions has also to follow without fail Acts and Rules comes under Kamataka Education Act 1983 (Karnataka Act No: 195)
8. This Educational Institution Registration as per Govt.Order No:ED 175 PMC 95 Dt:07/09/98 and Dt:29/12/98 is Permanently Without Aid.

9. Karnataka Private Institutions (Discipline and Controlling) Rules 1999 these rules has to be followed without fail.
10. To take suitable steps as per Karnataka Private Educational Institutions (Classification, Controlling/Regulation and Fixation of Text etc.,) Rules 1995 to teach only the Department and Government Fixed Text Books only and also to see there shall not be any book burden to the students.
11. As per Karnataka Educational Institutions (Classification, Regulation and Textbooks fixation etc.) Rules 1995 Dated: 04/10/96 of Rule-1 and Rule 19(04), a Broucher has to be printed at School Notice Board compulsorily and a copy of the same has to be submitted to Block Education Officer/ Deputy Director and also has to follow the department circulars properly.
12. Govt. Notification No: ED 39 V-99, Dt:14/03/2000 of Karnataka Educational Institutions (Regulation of Certain Fees and Donations) Rule -1999 has to be followed compulsorily and also follow the Circulations issued by Department from time to time.
13. Within 3 months from the date of obtaining the Permission , as per Karnataka Education Act 1983 (Act 1 of 1995) and as per section 36 to 39 and as per ED 131 VV 98, Bangalore, dated: 04/11/99 to renewal of the Recognised School, application has to be submitted to the concerned authorities and as per G.O. No: ED 369 PGC 2014 Dt:11/11/2014 and concerned Amendment Order to start the school Fixed Security Deposit Recognition renewal authority and this deposit is to be kept the Authority and Management Committee i.e. in Joint Account.
14. As per G.O.NO: ED 52 VV 99 Dt:2/2/200 of Annexure-5 each Class Ratio of both male and female and Teachers Ratio is to be followed strictly.



15. Only those who are having Educational Qualification and Training as per Department Rules has to be appointed as Teachers and to provide service security to the Teachers and staff it is compulsory. From 6th to 8th standard Teachers who are having Training only B.Ed teachers is to be appointed.
16. School working period and days has to be followed as per Department Rules.
17. The students admission after starting of the school such Admission or starting of Academic that particular year, is to inform within 3 months to this office. In case if the School not opened or fails to follow the any of the rules this Order will automatically cancelled.
18. If there is already 1 to 7th Standard Kannada Medium is there, due to the grant of English Medium Primary School is to see that there shall not be any harm to the Kannada Medium Schools.
19. As per G.O.NO: ED 27 SEP 93 Dt: 13/02/2003 to follow the instructions compulsorily, Service Details of the Teachers/ Staff recorded properly and compulsorily maintained.
20. If the records submitted are found false, this Registration shall be cancelled and Each Class Students Nos. shall not exceed more than 50.
21. There shall not be any transfer and shift of the school premises after grant of the permission upto 5 years.
22. As per G.O.NO: ED 122 SES 2007, Bangalore, Dated: 17/5/2007 has to fulfil all the conditions in the letter.
23. To run the School for which medium from 1 to 5th Standard the school shall be run the same Medium.
24. As per G.O.NO: ED 369 2014 Dt: 11/11/2014 and related Amendment Order instructed, compulsorily to provide School Basic amenities and other conditions, and in this regard after getting the confirmation only, B.E.O. has to issue Recognition.



24. To undertake suitable action/steps about the safety of the students at schools as per the issuance of guidelines of Education Department and Home Departments and has to provide all security equipments in the school.
25. To observe properly the running of the schools whether the schools are running as per Registration Rules.
